

I-MATE 'PUSHES' E-MAIL

PDA and smartphone vendor i-mate has announced a new push e-mail upgrade for all its Windows Mobile 5.0 devices, available from its 'Club i-mate' website at www.clubimate.com. The upgrade - called 'Messaging & Security Feature Pack' (MSFP) - is tied to Microsoft's Exchange 2003 Service Pack 2 and, according to i-mate, delivers the same experience as other push e-mail systems, but without the expense of an additional relay server and extra client licences.
